PLANNING TO HAVE YOUR CHILD BE BAPTIZED IN CHURCH?

Here are the requirements for baptism: Parents and sponsors are required to attend the baptismal preparation class prior to baptism. The next class will be on Monday, April 22, 2024, at 6pm in Truckee (bilingual). Walk-ins are not allowed.

- The child must be under 7 years old, or the child will have to take the RCIC first.
- Parents who are not married in the Catholic Church must schedule a meeting with Fr. Vince prior to attending the baptismal preparation class.
- Sponsors must have received the three sacraments of initiation: Baptism, Eucharist & Confirmation, and at least 16 years old.
- Sponsors must be in good standing with the church: if married, married in Church, and if single, must not be cohabitating with a partner.
- Baptismal and Sponsor forms must be completed and submitted together with the birth certificate of the child, confirmation certificate(s) of the godparent(s), if married, a copy of the Church marriage certificate is required.
- Please call the office at (530) 587-3595, for the form and to sign-up for the monthly baptismal preparation class. For the class, the parish is asking for a donation of \$20 per couple and \$20 for the pair of sponsors.

HOW TO OFFER MASS INTENTION?

You may offer Mass intention for a particular birthday, anniversary, healing, special intention, etc. Normally, it is one Mass, one intention except if it is a collective Mass intention on Saturdays or Sundays in Spanish. The Diocese set the donation per Mass intention at \$10.00/ per Mass. If you wish to receive a Mass card with your Mass intention, an additional \$5.00 will be collected per Mass intention.

ADOPT A PEW IN KINGS BEACH FOR \$1,000

CCD & RCIA REGISTRATION DEADLINE JUNE 28TH, 2024

All students are required to register each year, including those who are moving to the 2nd year CCD program. Due to the limited number of catechists, we will no longer accept students outside of the age range for first communion and confirmation. Please make sure that your child is within the age range requirement of the parish, especially for the first year, First Communion. Your child may have to wait until they are 18 years old and join the RCIA platform for their catechetical formation. Here is the age range for first communion and confirmation: **First Communion (first year)** – between 6 to 8 years old. **Confirmation (first year)** – between 11 to 14 years old.

THINKING OF GETTING MARRIED AT ASSUMPTION PARISH?

Starting January 2024, couples not registered in the parish or not physically residing in the parish boundaries, must start their marriage preparation no less than 8 months prior to the wedding date. The engaged couple must do their marriage preparation at their home parish and must provide the name and contact number of the priest or minister who will be preparing them. The couple must sign the contract with Assumption Parish and complete all the required documents of the Diocese of Sacramento. The contract and check list of the requirements are available at the parish office. A non refundable deposit is required to reserve the wedding date.

SEARCHING FOR PART-TIME OFFICE ASSISTANT

We are looking for a part-time office assistant who can work at the office on Mon., Tues., Thurs., and Fri., at least 12hours per week. Interested applicants must be computer literate, preferably bilingual, with good people and organizational skills, must be in good standing with the Church, must have a pleasing personality, and must pass all the Diocesan requirements for new hire. Interested applicants may send their resume to the parish office.

SCHEDULE YOUR DESTINATION WEDDING FOR 2025

We are promoting our two churches as destination wedding places. Couples who come from outside of the parish/diocese, must complete their marriage preparation class at their local parish. Please make sure that you comply and complete all the marriage requirements of the Diocese of Sacramento at least a month prior to the wedding date. We require all destination weddings to reserve Assumption Church or Our Lady of the Lake Mission Church at least 8 months to a year in advance.

HOW TO ADDRESS RECEPTION OF COMMUNION AT MASS?

Those who are practicing Catholics, in good standing with the Church, have received their first communion, and those not conscious of any grave sin, may receive communion during Mass. With regards to the rest of the congregation: For Non-Catholics - you may convert to Catholicism through the RCIA process, for Non-practicing Catholics - oftentimes, confession is the only thing you need, if you are in an irregular marriage situation (civilly married, cohabitating without marriage, remarried outside of the Church without annulment) or if you are in a moral predicament, please set an appointment with your local priest or Fr. Vince and see if there is a remedy to your situation.
